- **Refuelling** All fuels to be stored in appropriate bunded containers and refuelling to take place in designated areas on drip trays.
- Access/egress of workforce/subcontractors workforce to mobilise to site in the least number of vehicles as possible.
- **Depletion of resources** All materials to be accurately estimated and stored as per guidelines to prevent waste.
